For all of us who wait each year with eager longing for the coming of September and the Ministry Fair; for all of us who at the beginning of each October start crossing off the days until the next Ministry Fair Sunday with big red Xs and counting down; for all of us who equate the pounding in of the stakes that hold the Ministry Fair signs with the return of the swallows to Capistrano; and even for all of us who really like the tasty treats at each ministry's table, I'm afraid I have some difficult news.

We've decided not to do this in 2018-2019.

Even though we pray for our various ministries throughout the year during the Prayers of the People, at this point we really only spotlight them at the Ministry Fair. Given the number of active ministries we have going here at Trinity, this presents us with a lot to look at, a lot of questions to ask, and a lot of information to absorb in a relatively short period of time, with little or no time for savoring or considering participating in something new.

Taking a line from "Monty Python", we now say along with John Cleese, "And now for something completely different."


Starting this October and running through May 2019, we've decided to designate the second Sunday of every month as Ministry Sunday as a way of encouraging all of us to explore new ministry opportunities. Every month two or three parish ministries will be highlighted in written articles in the Trinity Talk, and on the second Sunday of the month each of the featured ministries will be invited to advertise/promote themselves after both services as they so choose. Ministry representatives will be on hand to answer our questions or to explain the ministry's focus in greater detail – and new participants are always welcome!

Let me also toss out this thought for consideration: like all living things, parish ministries have a life cycle and their impact and effectiveness will ebb and flow with the passage of time and with the changing of the world and of our own City of Orange and Orange County. Sometimes, for various reasons, ministries need to be ended – as with Trinity's direct participation in the much-loved Corazon organization.

But just as there can be a time for a particular ministry to end, there are also appropriate, Spirit inspired times in a parish for new ministries to be born, or to be reconfigured. If God is calling you to something that doesn't exist here yet; if the Spirit keeps putting the same idea into your head again and again; if the person next to you in the pew is saying, "I think you should go for it", then please come see me and we'll talk. Who knows? This just might be the absolutely right time for a new way to love and serve God to come into being!

And back to a quick word to current ministry leaders: when it's your ministry's turn to be featured, Amy will send you an email a month before to allow you time to give her whatever material you'd like to appear in Trinity Talk. Feel free to wax eloquent!

"And now for something completely different" was often the cue for John Cleese's desk to explode. That's not exactly what we're striving for here, but you just might find yourself "blown away" by all the ministry opportunities we have available here!



BOOK CLUB

The Book Club will be meeting on **Saturday** August 11th. This month the group will read Everything I Never Told You by Celeste Ng. The discussion will be from 9:30am—11am. Please join them for a rewarding literary morning. A synopsis follows:

So begins the story of this exquisite debut novel, about a Chinese American family living in 1970s small-town Ohio. Lydia is the favorite child of Marilyn and James Lee; their middle daughter, a girl who inherited her mother's bright blue eyes and her father's jet-black hair. Her parents are determined that Lydia will fulfill the dreams they were unable to pursue—in Marilyn's case that her daughter become a doctor rather than a homemaker, in James's case that Lydia be popular at school, a girl with a busy social life and the center of every party.

When Lydia's body is found in the local lake, the delicate balancing act that has been keeping the Lee family together is destroyed, tumbling them into chaos. James, consumed by guilt, sets out on a reckless path that may destroy his marriage. Marilyn, devastated and vengeful, is determined to find a responsible party, no matter what the cost. Lydia's older brother, Nathan, is certain that the neighborhood bad boy Jack is somehow involved. But it's the youngest of the family—Hannah—who observes far more than anyone realizes and who may be the only one who knows the truth about what happened.

A profoundly moving story of family, history, and the meaning of home, Everything I Never Told You is both a gripping page-turner and a sensitive family portrait, exploring the divisions between cultures and the rifts within a family, and uncovering the ways in which mothers and daughters, fathers and sons, and husbands and wives struggle, all their lives, to understand one another.
