## Trinity's AEDs or Automatic External Defibrillators

As some of you may know, your Faith Community Nurses hold our CPR/AED certification class for the ushers and office staff every two years. After our last class, it became evident that not everyone knew we had TWO AEDs and where they were located. The use of this device is critical to saving lives in the event of a sudden cardiac arrest. Everyone at Trinity needs to know the location of these devices.

One AED is located in the office on the wall leading directly into Rev Annie's old office. The second is in the Parish Hall's large kitchen on the wall as you go directly through the kitchen door. Each is colored bright red and is secured on the wall but is easily removed by sliding it out of its bracket.

Any of your nurses will gladly show you where the devices are located and answer any questions you may have. In our class we are instructed to use three commands if we encounter an apparent cardiac emergency, "You call 911, you get the AED, and come right back."

We all can be members of a life-saving team. Let's all do our part to be prepared.

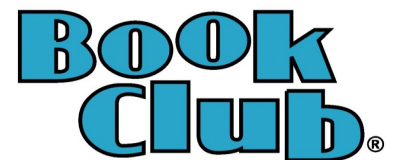

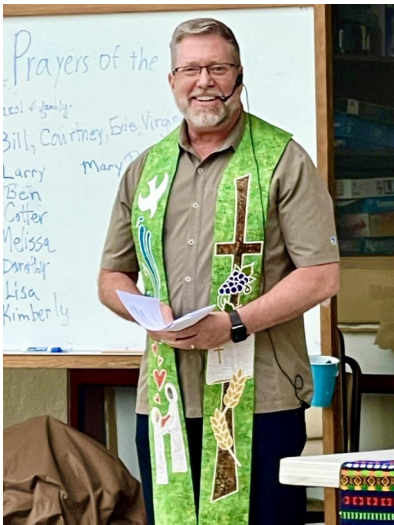
