
We cannot do it without you! Won't you help Trinity reach its budgeting goal for 2024?

We hope you will join us for this very special event, Advent & Sweets.




### **BLUE CHRISTMAS SERVICE**

## ANNUAL YOUTH CHIRSTMAS DINNER AND GIFT EXCHANGE! Date TBA! Be on the look out.


We will meet at the youth center for a potluck dinner. Afterwards we will exchange silly gifts (value \$10 to \$15). This is a really fun event and friends are welcome.

### Trinity Faith Community Nurse (FCN) News

Trinity now has a 3rd AED due to the bountiful generosity of Hoag and our FCN Program. This new 3rd AED is located in the Bride's Room on the left wall as you immediately enter the room. Its location is marked by a three dimensional AED sign in the sanctuary. The new AED is encased in an alarmed cabinet that will sound like a siren when opened but will turn off once it is closed. This alarm will help deter theft as well as alert everyone of an emergency. Please familiarize yourself with this new defibrillator as



well as our two other AED's located in the church office and the large kitchen in the parish hall. The use of these devices are critical to saving lives. Any of your nurses will gladly answer any questions you may have. In CPR Training classes we are instructed to use 3 commands as you point to 2 specific people.

"you call 911, you get the AED and come right back."


