Thank you for making this Holy week a time to remember.

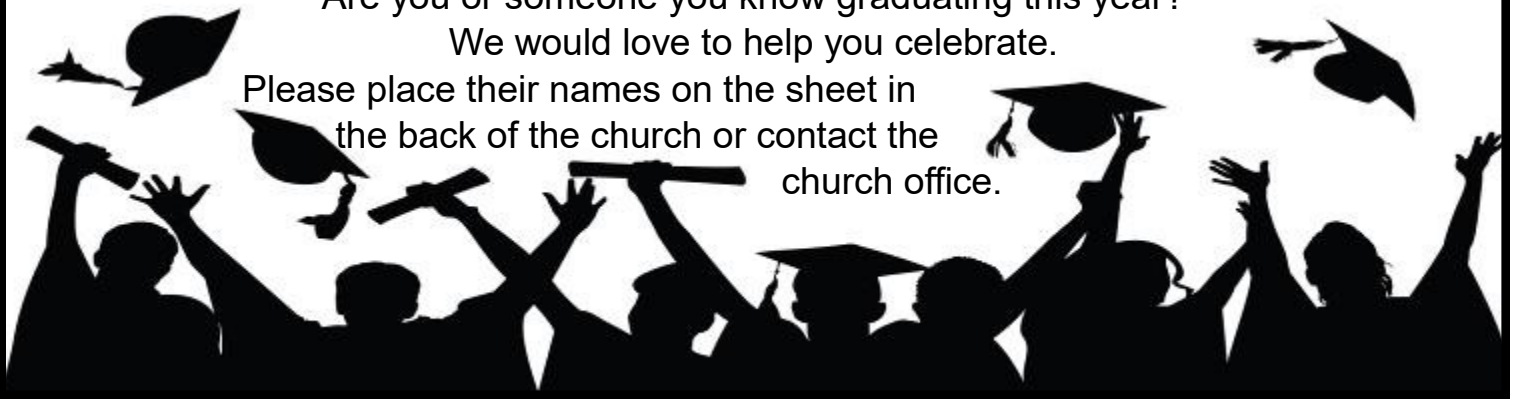
