# The Book Club

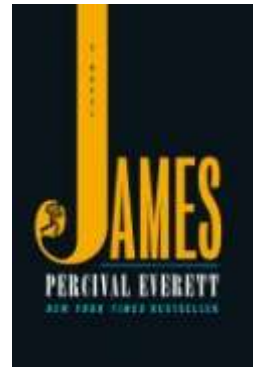
## Saturday, February 8th

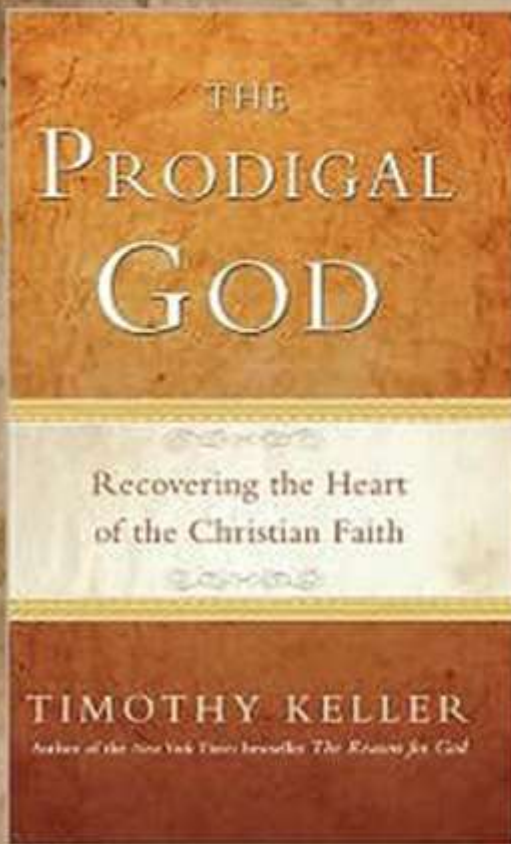
